

# Organic Cane Molasses

**Description:** Organic Cane molasses is a by-product consisting of the syrupy residue that is collected during the manufacture or refining of organic sugar from organic sugar cane. It is characterised by its excellent palatability, high energy content and its flexibility of use.

**Feeding Guidelines:** Organic Cane molasses is a flexible nutritious feed. It can be fed in a diet feeder as part of a TMR, top-dressed on forages or mixed with a variety of dry feeds. Furthermore, it also complements grass-based diets, where its rapidly digestible sugars are an ideal balancer to the highly degradable protein in the forage.

**Dairy Cows:** Up to 3kg (normal 1-2kg) per head per day or 15% of the total diet mix.

**Beef Cattle:** Up to 2.5kg (normal 1-2 kg) per head per day or 15% of the total diet mix.

**Young Cattle:** Up to 1.5kg or 5% of the total diet mix.

**Sheep:** Lambs 10% of diet (0.4 kg per head per day) and ewes 15% of diet (0.8kg per head per day).
